Addendum to the Reconsideration Protocol

Effective: July 8, 2026

Introduction

This document provides supplementary guidance regarding the process for requesting an extension of time to file a Reconsideration Request.

Background

In accordance with the Protocol and Section 7.05 of the Settlement Agreement, a Claimant is entitled to file a Reconsideration Request upon receiving either a Notice of Claim Denial or a Notice of Approval at a level lower than that specified on the Claimant's Category 2 Claim Form.

Under the Reconsideration Protocol, a Reconsideration Request Form must be filed within 120 days from the date indicated on the Notice of Claim Denial or the Notice of Approval at a lower level than requested. The Reconsideration Request Form must include all information pertinent to the Claimant's reconsideration, including any additional explanations or documentation. Obtaining additional explanations or documentation may require a period of time that exceeds the 120-day filing deadline.

Reconsideration Request Extension Protocol

1. Where a Claimant or their representative counsel requires additional time to prepare and submit a Reconsideration Request Form, a Request for Extension Form must be submitted to the Claims Administrator at claims@boardinghomesclassaction.com.
2. The Request for Extension must be received by the Claims Administrator prior to the expiration of the 120-day filing period, as calculated from the date indicated on the Notice of Claim Denial or the Notice of Approval at a lower level than requested.
3. The Claimant must specify the duration of the extension sought and provide a detailed explanation of the reasons necessitating the request. The Claims

Administrator may deny a Request for Extension or grant a different period where the duration sought or the rationale provided is considered unreasonable.

4. The extension period for filing a Reconsideration Request may not exceed 120 days beyond the original filing deadline as indicated on the Notice of Claim Denial or Notice of Approval at a lower level than requested, (i.e. a maximum of 8 months following the date of denial is allocated for reconsideration).
